BRICKS AND MORTAR chased toward the rear of midfield, raced inside INTELLOGENT through the first turn, continued patiently down the backstretch and in the two to three path around the far turn, gained approaching the quarter pole while still going easily, waited for room into the lane, got room three wide near the three sixteenths, rallied under a drive, and led with a sixteenth of a mile remaining. MAGIC WAND (IRE) raced keenly inside early while lightly bumped several times by CATCHO EN DIE, tracked the leading pair inside of CATCHO EN DIE and INTELLOGENT through the first turn, sat in the pocket behind the leading flight down the backstretch, was pushed along in the two path from the seven sixteenths, shifted two wide past the quarter pole for a bid, was outkicked by the winner but kept on well between horses for the place. BANDUA was pushed along for pace, dictated unchallenged terms through the far turn and into the backstretch, took mild pressure from HUNTING HORN approaching the five eighths mark, set the pace in the two path through the far turn while still being prompted, asserted himself on the lead to the stretch, clung tenaciously to the lead, was caught with a sixteenth of a mile remaining but kept on gamely to the wire. ROBERT BRUCE (CHI) settled near the rear inside of PIVOINE, continued patiently in the two path through the far turn, swung six wide in upper stretch, offered a smart belated rally and was gaining to the wire. PIVOINE (IRE) settled near the rear outside of ROBERT BRUCE, continued outside of that foe through the far turn, swung seven wide into upper stretch, and offered a mild rally outside foes. INTELLOGENT (IRE) came away slightly awkwardly and grazed the gate, chased three wide early, settled outside of BRICKS AND MORTAR into the first turn, , continued midfield down the backstretch, was pushed along in the three path on the far turn and offered a mild bid, fanned five wide into the lane, and chased two to three wide without making any further impact. CAPTIVATING MOON grazed the gate, settled at the rear, switched two wide into the far turn, continued at the rear in the three path around the bend, made a mild inside rally in upper stretch but found himself outfinished in the final furlong. HUNTING HORN (IRE) stalked just behind and outside of BANDUA, began to mildly press outside of BANDUA from approaching the five eighths mark, came into the second turn between that foe and CATCHO EN DIE, continued to prompt the pace in the three path through the second turn, came three wide into the lane, and weakened in the final furlong. CATCHO EN DIE (ARG) tracked between horses early, did some slight bumping with MAGIC WAND during the first run down the stretch, continued to track the leading pair two wide through the first turn and two to three wide down the backstretch, was pushed along three wide into the second turn, loomed just outside and behind the leading pair in the four path through the second turn, came into the lane four wide, but was empty for the drive.
