FLAP JACK bumped with the horse to his outside leaving the gate, raced on the inside just behind the frontrunners up the backstretch, came around the turn in the two path, ran into traffic approaching the quarter pole, forced through a hole entering the stretch and pulled clear while drifting in the final furlong. WOOPIGSOOIE trailed far behind the field while drifting some in the opening half mile, got moving from the three path around the turn, launched a bold bid between horses passing the eighth pole and gained ground in late stretch to get up for second. PERUVIAN BOY raced into traffic and steadied in the opening quarter of a mile, settled on the outside for what remained of the backstretch, raced in the three path around the turn and gained ground on the outside in late stretch. BRECKENRIDGE raced inside in tight quarters up the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, found room to make a bid on the rail in upper stretch and was outkicked in the final furlong. LYKAN pressed the pace on the outside up the backstretch, moved up to properly challenge near the three eighths pole, raced in the four path around the turn and flattened out in the stretch. FAST DREAMER bumped with the horse to his inside leaving the gate, pressed the pace between horses up the backstretch, moved up to challenge from the two path passing the three eighths pole and weakened in the final furlong. VINCENT WILLIAM showed early speed, led the field on the inside under pressure up the backstretch, dueled on the rail around the turn and tired between horses entering the stretch.
