MIND CONTROL broke well and was forwardly placed six paths off the inside early on before advancing to poke a head in front six and a half furlongs from home, showed the way given some rein to work with five paths off the inside under little pressure albeit accompanied by the presence of SOUPER JACKPOT to the outside, came under light coaxing near the half mile pole and tucked to the two path at that station, got coaxed along at the seven-sixteenths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and inched away through the final furlong to prevail. OUR BRAINTRUST seven then six paths off the inside down the backstretch in range of the leader, tucked two to three wide through the turn, remained patiently handled until called upon continuing two to three wide into upper stretch, ran on willingly through to the finish to secure the place honors. FAMILY BIZ bumped at the start by DIRECT ORDER who broke outwards, chased five then four wide down the backstretch from near the rear of compact group, tucked inside half a mile from home, came under a ride at the seven-sixteenths, cut the corner into upper stretch and improved position through the stretch to procure the show honors in the late stages. GATES OF DAWN broke out at the start and traded a bump with SOUPER JACKPOT, chased nine then eight paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked four wide into the turn, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths advancing into contention swinging four wide at the quarter pole, dug in under a drive weakening in the late stages and shied out while being shown the near sided stick inside the final sixteenth. SOUPER JACKPOT traded a bump at the break with GATES OF DAWN, led early on while in hand and was headed for the front six and a half furlongs from home, attended the leader while well off the inside down the backstretch nine then eight paths, tucked to the three path half a mile from home, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung three wide at the head of the stretch and weakened in the drive. DIRECT ORDER broke out at the start bumping FAMILY BIZ, chased eight then seven paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked three to four wide through the turn coaxed along from the three-eighths, angled five wide for home and trailed throughout.
