

## **Footnotes**

HAIKAL took up position near the back of the pack after brushing with INSTAGRAND at the start, was riding the left rim of the two path stepping onto the turn, picked up interest departing the three-eighths pole, was under a drive spinning four wide into the stretch, narrowed in, shifted out into path six from left side stick work, saw the rider switch to opposite side only to continue to shy away from any side stick work was being applied, surged to the front a few strides short of the wire and edged away. MIND CONTROL went away from MUCH BETTER as the field was sent off and running, got guided over to the inside, tracked the leader from afar, sprang to life getting set down approaching the quarter pole, closed in with a rush to hitch up to the leader a sixteenth down the road, with INSTAGRAND joining them shortly afterwards, left the eighth pole vying with vigour as the innermost of three, forged to top late only to get overpowered by HAIKAL. INSTAGRAND brushed at the start, quickly settled into stride, assumed a forward position, kept watch on the loose leader three wide, in between rivals during the run around the bend, commenced the stretch by tipping slighty wider, latched on to the front runners, began the final furlong fighting as the widest of a threesome, kept up the pursuit in earnest before flattening out in the final seventy yards. MUCH BETTER came in after losing her footing at the start, shouldering the second place finisher, moved up to the top, quickened shaking free of KNICKS GO approaching the half mile pole, sailed along on an open lead strung out three to four wide, got pounced upon coming up to the three-sixteenths pole, fought with distinction between rivals from deep into the furlong grounds onward only to have to settle for the last major check. FAMILY BIZ rode the rail for three-quarters, angled four wide into the lane, made no headway in the final furlong. TIKHVIN FLEW sat three wide in midpack in pursuit of the pace, got sent out into path five after entering

the stretch, had no rally. KNICKS GO disputed the pace from path two until the conclusion of the backstretch, steadily retreated on the turn, stepped into the lane put to a protective hold and was still under it making it across the wire. NOT THAT BRADY acting fractious stepping onto the track, came away to an apparent clean get-away, raced from off the inside throughout, went about the turn from path four, failed to pick it up when asked past the midway point, swung into the lane under a protective hold and would remain under it, was then pulled up quickly once over the finish line.
