The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 122lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstake other than state-bred allowed 2 lbs.; of a race other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance allowed 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, October 19, 2019 with 16 Nominations.

MAEDEAN away without apparent mishap, raced at a considerable distance from off the inside, stepped onto the turn from path four, closed in, enough so as to compete as the widest of a foursome beginning from the three-eighths pole, ventured onward on hold whittling away at the deficit, turned into the lane and was in the general area of the three-sixteenths pole before finally getting turned loose, being the last of that grouping to have its pilot commit to a ride, responded willingly, emerging at the eighth pole as the new and undisputed leader, lengthened away under good handling. POWER MOVE remained in the three path after the field had been released, was content to keep an eye on the front runners towards the midpack for the opening half, joined the pace picture approaching the midway point on the turn, went on to take part in it as one of the middle members of a quartet, loomed boldly heading into the lane, was nearing the three-sixteenths marker when put to a drive, got beaten to the front end by the winner, proved no match in the final furlong but had enough stretch energy to secure second. VAST got tipped into the two path proceeding along the chute, was let out a notch having lost ground during the setting of the second split, even though the tempo had not quickened, left the three-eighths pole having been set down, swung five wide, the widest of all, into the stretch, failed to make any headway, wandered in a couple of paths in deep stretch, reacting to some right side stick work, bumped solidly with ANKLE MONITOR in the shadow of the wire then went to narrowly best that one. ANKLE MONITOR rode the rail for the majority of the first six furlongs, went three wide spinning into the lane for the drive home, failed to muster up a solid closing punch, made hard contact with VAST in the final stages as the twosome were vying for the last in-the-money slot, fell short of snagging it. SWEET KISSES gained a slim lead soon after the start, moved over onto the rail, carved out the pace pulling a bit on the left and with CEE'S OVERTURE in accompaniment to the outside, came under heavier pressure when the top twosome hitched up halfway on the bend, desperately clung to an advantage that was shrinking stride after stride, was set down a couple of jumps shy of the quarter pole, gave in shortly afterwards and backed away. CEE'S OVERTURE pressed the issue from the two path, going about it from between opponents from the three-eighths pole until right around the three-sixteenths marker, gave way in the final furlong. Following a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the stretch run in addition to a claim of foul lodged by the rider of ANKLE MONITOR against the rider of VAST, the latter was disqualified from third and placed fourth for causing interference.
