The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs.

Non-winners of a sweepstake other than state-bred allowed 2 lbs.; of a race other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance allowed 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, October 19, 2019 with 28 Nominations.

Footnotes

INDEPENDENCE HALL away in good order, was a contender for the top in short order, going about the task in the two path, picked in interest when let out a notch in the form of some hand encouragement to begin to edge away from the competition during the final stages of the run around the bend, settled in upper stretch and got called upon for more, took charge, came in one path from one right side shot leaving the eighth pole, ducked out two to three paths a few strides later after the pilot switched the whip to the opposite, saw the rider resort to a hand drive, became professional and drew even farther away from the others, most impressively. MERU lost his footing springing from the gate, then was steadied getting pinched right afterwards, departed the backstretch from path four, improved position from the top of the bend until its end, got set down for the drive home, proved no match while nailing down the place. CHASE TRACKER underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, got sent out into path five from upper to midstretch, went on to secure the show. FAMISHED gradually made his way over to the inside route, attaining the spot by the top of the backstretch, continued on it for three-quarters, fanned out six wide racing down the stretch, practically becoming the widest of all, mustered up a mild response that was sufficient enough for the last major check. ASHAAR appearing keen while pulling on the bit, disputed the pace towards path three as the outermost of a trio for three-quarters and gave way. LIVEYOURBEASTLIFE took up the chase from path two, in between foes for nearly six furlongs, commenced the stretch one path farther off the rail, had no rally. SPYCRAFT remained along the rail after the start, argued inside a pair of rivals for most of the trip leading up to the quarter pole, got shaken off by the

top one then backed away steadily down the stretch. AMERICANUS pocketed until the head of the stretch, faltered. LEBDA strung out three wide and between opponents on the turn, swung six wide into the lane, folded.
