For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$1,500 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs.

Non-winners of a graded sweepstake allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstake or a race other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance allowed 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, October 24, 2020 with 17 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement.

Footnotes

PICKIN' TIME along the outside, sat perched three wide during the run around the bend, got cued up going after the ones to catch in earnest entering the stretch, clawed his way to the front end during the ensuing furlong, kicked clear, driving. TEN FOR TEN grabbed the advantage shortly after the start, was spotted towards the inside route on the lead, pressed by ISOLATE from the outside, inched away from that one as three-quarters was being completed only to come under aim by the winner right afterwards, surrendered making its way through the furlong grounds, stayed on to finish well clear of the others for second. ISOLATE pressed the issue two to three wide on the turn, was more the latter coming into the lane, swerved out while backing away in midstretch, straightened away and continued his retreat. NOVA RAGS took up the chase primarily from the two path, slid over to the rail in time to cut the corner into the lane, had no response. CIVIL WAR sent over to the rail nearing the half mile pole, went three wide into the lane, made no gain. IRISH HONOR yanked towards the inside shortly after the start, was three wide entering the turn and sent out five wide exiting it, never made his presence felt. SPECTATORLESS two wide in pursuit of the front runners on the turn, was through after going six furlongs.
