## Footnotes

BROOKLYN STRONG away alertly, dropped back into a stalking role, chased the pace three wide until the quarter pole, got cued up spinning into the stretch, clawed his way towards the one to catch during the ensuing furlong, appeared undeterred getting carried out a few paths by an errant TEN FOR TEN in midstretch, that one's rider applying some left side stick work at the time, ground his way to the front end with gameness to get the job done. TEN FOR TEN glided over into the two path with the advantage coming up to the end of the homestretch, rated well, showing the way on a loosely-contested lead, continued along under the same scenario until the end of the second bend, felt the presence of the top one when finally called upon for more in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, saw the winner become fully hitched up, came out after some left side shots at the eighth pole, taking BROOKLYN STRONG along for an abbreviated ride, failed to intimidate that one, dug in with good determination but got reeled in. KNOWN AGENDA bumped with its next stall neighbor after leaning in with his initial step, displayed no lasting ill effects and tucked along the inside route, kept watch on the second place finisher loosely pocketed, failed to pick up interest when asked to on the backstretch, was maneuvered to the outside shortly after three-quarters had been reeled off, fanned out wider and wider until in the neighborhood of path six by the start of the final furlong, proved no match while easily securing the show. PICKIN' TIME made contact with KNOWN AGENDA in the shadow of the starting gate, went on to stalk the pace from the two path, swung out four wide onto the head of the stretch, gave way. ERAWAN reserved for the opening six furlongs pursuing the leader towards the two path, came under a ride by the five-sixteenths pole, angled three wide into the stretch, backed away.
