STAKES Central Park S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$1,000 (in addition to the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight, 122 lbs.

Non-winners of a sweepstake allowed 2 lbs.; of a race other than Maiden, Claiming or Starter, allowed 4 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. Closed Saturday, November 16, 2019 with 30 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the Main Track.) (Rail at 27 feet).

Footnotes

PIXELATE four wide into the first turn, raced three wide through that bend before settling four wide outside a pair just in behind the top pair down the backstretch, tucked to the two path three furlongs from home, came under coaxing nearing the quarter pole, swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive on his wrong lead and under a near sided stick rallying in tandem with HOMELAND to his outside to collar the leader a sixteenth from home, dug in and was bumped by HOMELAND inside that station, then traded two minor bumps leaning on each other while prevailing gamely at the finish. HOMELAND bumped at the start by OLD CHESTNUT, settled three wide in pursuit from near the rear of the field, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied to latch on the aforementioned foe nearing the eighth pole albeit with one to two paths between them, dug in under a drive catching the leader as a pair a sixteenth from home, came in under an off sided stick bumping PIXELATE inside that station, then traded minor bumps and leans to the finish and was ultimately rebuffed at the end. MR. KRINGLE three wide into the first turn, knocked heads three then two wide with ASHRAQ to his inside down the backstretch and into the far turn, took over narrow command placed to coaxing five-sixteenths from home, swung three then two wide into upper stretch, inched away under a drive to the eighth pole, dug in under threat from a pair and was collared a sixteenth from home, ran on to the finish to just hold for the show honors on the wire. CITY MAN off half a beat slow, got steadied in tight one mile from home after leaving the infield chute inside of HOMELAND and in behind MO READY for a sixteenth of a mile before able to settle at the tail of the field, saved ground at the rear, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled out four to five wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild kick to just miss for the show honors. MO READY broke out at the start and was corrected, pulled a bit keen early on under a firm hold inside before settling to track from just off the pace along the inside of a pair, came under light coaxing three furlongs out, spun three wide into upper stretch and weakened. ASHRAQ forwardly placed just off the inside early on, established command and showed the way just off the inside through the opening bend before taking to the rail down the backstretch,

knocked heads in hand with MR. KRINGLE to the outside down the backstretch and into the far turn, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths as that rival began to take slight advantage, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and weakened in the final furlong. OLD CHESTNUT two to three wide in pursuit from just off the pace through the opening half mile between foes heads apart just off the dueling leaders, began to fade through the far turn and was placed to coaxing five-sixteenths from home, continued two to three wide into upper stretch and tired. There was a Stewards' inquiry into the stretch run as well as a Jockey's objection by the rider of HOMELAND alleging interference against PIXELATE in the stretch which was reviewed and dismissed prior to the result standing and the race being declared official.
