STAKES New York Stallion Series S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR TWO YEARS OLD ELIGIBLE FOR THE NEW YORK STALLION STAKES. All foals by Nominated Stallions will be automatically eligible for all of the New York Stallion Series races. By subscription of \$250 which should accompany the nomination. \$1,875 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,875 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$3,750 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. All monies to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 5% of purses won to be awarded to the stallion nominator. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a race other than maiden or claiming allowed 2 lbs.; maidens allowed 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, November 21, 2020 with 19 Nominations.

HOLD THE SALSA stalked the pace three wide, inched up towards the ones to catch during the run around the bend, got roused swinging into the four path heading home being, closed in resolutely on the leader, struck the front end in deep stretch, then dug in to preserve the decision. IT'S GRAVY took up the chase from path two, was worked into the fifth one from upper to midstretch, closed in with willingness, came up short. MARKET ALERT vied for command towards path two during the initial stages, was more on the inside route coming into the stretch, gave in to the winner with under a sixteenth to go, stayed on for the show. WINDY NATIONS came in losing his footing springing from the gate, travelled four wide on the turn, got sent out into path six from upper stretch, gained well enough to earn the last major check. PROSPECT MOUNTAIN saved ground until the end of the bend, got maneuvered into path six once in the stretch, made no impact. HORN OF PLENTY brushed at the start, settled into midpack, raced three wide on the turn, was put to urging spinning

about as wide into the stretch, lacked the necessary response. DREAMER'S DISEASE stumbled badly at the start, appeared keen while advancing afterwards towards the front end, argued for command until midstretch, then gave way. THE KING CHEEK a forward factor from along the inside route, faltered. NEW YORK ONE faltered off a ground-saving journey. JACOBA pinched at the start, left the backstretch from the two path, was never in it. JACKS AMERICAN PIE two wide at the top of the turn, failed to contend.
