## Footnotes

BANK ON SHEA underwent a two wide pursuit on the turn, got asked for more leaving the five-sixteenths pole, altered over to the inside route entering the top of the lane, narrowed in on the ones to catch, getting up in time to win the bob. DREAM BIGGER sat forwardly placed four wide, began to inch up approaching the end of the bend, swung into the stretch and took off in earnest, out-dueled MOONACHIE to gain a slim advantage with approximately a sixteenth to, tired to preserve it but got nailed by the winner at the line. CAPTAIN BOMBASTIC negatively impacting some of the others making his way into the pocket by the head of the backstretch, tracked the front runners without making its presence felt, was cued up angling to the outside from the

five-sixteenths pole, settled in at the four path a furlong later, went on to secure the show. MOONACHIE disputed the pace from the three path, took over coming up to the five-sixteenths pole, got let out for the drive home, relinquished reluctantly in the general area of the sixteenth pole and weakened. TURBO DRIVE took the inside route to the end of the bend, rallied mildly in the final furlong for a minor slice. CHOWDA strung out three wide on the turn, lacked the needed late response. COLORMEPAZZI vied for command from the two path until the five-sixteenths pole and faltered. KIERKEGAARD three wide onto the turn, gave way. GIANT SHOES parked out four to five wide on the turn, came up empty. BIG PACKAGE bumped into by a maneuvering CAPTAIN BOMBASTIC nearing the end of the chute, went on to save ground on the turn to no avail. TERCERO strung out four wide on the turn, failed to menace. HOLD MY CALL bobbled at the start, steadied as CAPTAIN BOMBASTIC was taking up residence early on the turn, rode the rail at least to the end of the bend and faltered. Fog obscured the viewing of the race.
