## **Footnotes**

A FREUD OF MAMA took up residence in the two path after the start, was rated in midpack for the opening half, picked it up being sent to the outside at the five-sixteenths pole, secured the three path and took it for entrance into the stretch, closed in on the ones to catch after arriving at the furlong grounds, overhauled the embattled front runners inside the sixteenth pole then kicked well clear in the last seventy yards. OFFICER HUTCHY prompted the pace from the two path, well rated during the initial stages, was called upon for run spinning into the stretch, got hooked up with the TIME LIMIT leaving the eighth pole after having gotten shaken off earlier, continued onward with willingness to best that rival for place honors. TIME LIMIT established the top shortly after the field had been released, cut over to the inside route, carved out the pace, shadowed by the second place finisher from the outside, edged away to her largest lead after being turned loose in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, got reeled in by the top one with less than a sixteenth remaining, weakened enough late into the show slot. BANK STING reluctant to load, was bumped into by an incoming CENTRAL EXIT, showed no ill effects and attained a forward position, departed the backstretch from the three path, went into the lane, got worked into the four path over the course of the next furlong, rallied

mildly en route for the final significant slice of the purse. HOLMDEL PARK four wide on the turn, shifted out five wide exiting it, lacked a solid closing punch. BIG Q remained stationed along the inside route, came under a hand ride well before arriving at the conclusion of the backstretch, was still being hand ridden during the run around the bend, got roused stepping into the two path heading home, came up empty. SURE STITCH bumped at the start, saved ground to the quarter pole, angled five wide once in the stretch, had no impact. CLASSY SADIE checked after making contact with others several timesat the break and then right after the break, with some of that being more than a brush, underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, got steered out seven wide from upper to midlane, lacked the needed response. CENTRAL EXIT came in, bumping with its next stall neighbor, sat parked out five wide on the turn, was slightly wider entering the stretch, had no rally. DESBORDES chased the pace two wide after undergoing a couple of brushes in the shadow of the start, was yet in the same path coming into the lane, gave way. JIMMYS LASS guided onto the inside route after being brushed or bumped a few times shortly after start, went on to save ground to no avail, was eased after stepping into the lane, then walked off the track without need of outside assistance.
