MIDNIGHT BISOU away in good order, responded when put to mild hand encouragement to inch up towards COME DANCING, loosely drafted behind that opponent before sliding over to the rail nearing the conclusion of the backstretch, sat patiently pocketed on the turn, was forced to wait behind the previously-mentioned rival with a few jumps to spare before quarter pole, espied an escape route to the outside coming up to the head of the stretch, eagerly angled into it and was fed her cue, responded almost instantaneously to take charge by the eighth pole, extended the winning margin, fed a steady diet of light stick work in the area of the right shoulder to stay on course. COME DANCING rushed up to the front end after stumbling at the break, had control by the top of the backstretch, led the others, placed at a slight distance from off the rail and pulling a bit on the left side, made it to the quarter pole and was turned loose, succumbed when challenged by MIDNIGHT BISOU in the general area of the three-sixteenths pole, stayed on to secure second. MOPOTISM off the inside throughout, pursued the front runners from path three on the turn, commenced the stretch one path farther off the rail, closed in on the runner up in the last eighth, but fell short of the place. ESCAPE CLAUSE prompted the leader from the two path, going about her business from between rivals on the turn, stepped into the stretch and gave way. PACIFIC WIND rapidly set up in the two path, got ridden into path six heading for the three-sixteenths pole, lacked the needed response.
