FIRENZE FIRE assumed a forward position after the field had been sent off and running, stalked SHARE THE RIDE from path in between rivals during the run around the bend, was let out a notch a few jumps shy of the quarter pole, wandered towards path three challenging in earnest in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, wasted little time taking charge, extended the margin in the final furlong under good handling. FUNNY GUY contently brought up the back of the pack during the initial stages, glided into the four path from the top of the turn to its midway point, was in the four path spinning into the stretch, proved no match today rallying for the place. SHARE THE RIDE hustled from the gate to establish the top, got guided over to the rail, showed the way being rated along, felt an uptick in pressure as the half was being completed, went up to the three-sixteenths pole before getting called upon for more, got overpowered by FIRENZE FIRE, stayed on to earn the show award. TRUE TIMBER saved ground until the quarter pole, failed to fire appreciably after getting placed two wide at the head of the stretch. ENGAGE took up the chase three wide on the turn, swung into the lane, couldn't keep pace with the winner then gave way in the last eighth.
