SAIL BY was taken in hand early then rated comfortably in second position, ranged up in the two path on the final turn, was given her cue coming to the quarter-pole, rallied to the lead under a right-handed crop while three wide into upper stretch, switched to a left-handed crop while shaking clear into the final furlong, began to drift out shortly thereafter, was switched back to a right-handed crop outside the sixteenth-pole and held under strong urging. KINCHEN (IRE) broke out and bumped with a rival then was carried out early, angled in behind a drifting foe then dropped to the rail later on the opening bend, was reserved off the pace, traveled around the far turn in the two path, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, came four wide into the stretch, rallied in the final furlong and closed well to get the place. MCKULICK (GB) was forced out early then dropped to the three path, settled towards the back on the outside, went three wide on the final turn, was asked inside the five-sixteenths, swung six wide into the stretch, rallied outside in the final furlong and closed well to get the show. PHILLY EAGLES (IRE) was bumped at the start and forced out early then checked between horses while put in tight, angled in towards the rear, was unhurried at the back while saving ground, turned into the stretch in the two path while roused and lacked the needed response. HAIL TO drifted out badly shortly after the start and bothered some foes then dropped in, settled on the outside, went three wide on the final furlong bend, showed the way on a clear advantage, raced inside on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole then lost the lead into upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong and tired.
