JACK CHRISTOPHER was asked some leaving the gate then taken back under a strong hold early, tracked the pace on the outside, ranged up in the two to three path on the turn, took the lead passing the five-sixteenths, moved clear while roused into upper stretch, widened under a strong drive into the final furlong and maintained a safe advantage under strong urging. COMMANDPERFORMANCE brushed with a foe at the start while off a half-step slow, settled off the pace, was urged three then four wide on the turn, turned into the stretch under a drive and finished willingly for the place. WIT was last to commence, settled at the rear, saved ground on the turn, was caught behind foes from the five-sixteenths to the quarter-pole, came under urging outside the three-sixteenths and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. MY PRANKSTER moved out early then settled off the pace, was urged three to four wide on the turn, floated five wide into the stretch and came up empty. GUNITE brushed with a foe at the start, went to the front, showed the way with a clear advantage, was asked under threat at the three-eighths, lost the lead to the winner passing the five-sixteenths and faded. KAVOD settled off the pace, was urged along in the two path on the turn and failed to respond.
