INNER TURF FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. Non-Lasix Race pursuant to 4043.2 (7)(e)(5) Lasix not permitted within 48 hours of post time. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,000 (in addition to the entry and starting fees) can be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a race on the turf other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance allowed 2 lbs.; all maidens allowed 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, September 18, 2021 with 25 Nominations. ANNAPOLIS tracked the pace on the outside, engaged the leader leaving the backstretch, vied in the two path on the far turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, turned into upper stretch on even terms with the runner-up, dueled gamely with that foe to the wire and narrowly prevailed under strong handling. PORTFOLIO COMPANY went to the front, showed the way on the inside through moderate fractions, was asked while on even terms with ANNAPOLIS at the quarter-pole, dueled gamely inside that foe in the stretch and just missed while well clear for second. LIMITED LIABILITY bumped with a rival at the start, was reserved off the pace, saved ground on the far turn, was roused at the five-sixteenths, moved off the rail under the crop in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. DOCTOR JEFF bumped with an opponent at the start, settled on the outside, was asked while two then three wide on the turn and came up empty.
