## **Footnotes**

PLUM ALI away in good order, worked her way over to the hedge, narrowed the gap between calls on the backstretch, then continued to do so after stepping onto the far turn, picked up interest slipping to be outside CALDEE as six furlongs was being completed, turned into the lane on near even terms with the previously-mentioned foe, pilot holding something in reserve but with the other having been called upon for more by this juncture, had the rider go to work in the vicinity in the three-sixteenths pole, forged to the front, shook free in the final sixteenth under good handling. CALDEE brushed with MASHNEE after losing her footing springing from the starting gate, grabbed the advantage, showed the way from path two, pulling a bit on the bit, became more professional by midway on the backstretch, inched her way onto the inside route, saw the top one get taken to the outside at the five-sixteenths marker, got set down a sixteenth later with that one directly abreast, relinquished despite putting up a good fight from upper to midstretch, narrowly saved second. EDITOR AT LARGE (IRE) took up the chase from path two, shifted over to the hedge for a respite late on the second bend, got cued up back on the move to the outside heading for the top of the lane, drafted behind the winner before tipping into path three in the general area of the three-sixteenths marker, proved no match for the winner, missed the show. MASHNEE GIRL went on to save ground after making light contact with the second place finisher in the shadow of the starting gate, angled three wide into the lane, lacked the needed offering then ventured on to the finish line under light urging. DIRECTOR'S CUT kept the runner up company for three-quarters, primarily from path two, stepped into the lane appearing to have little left, then was allowed to fade away, lightly encouraged.
