

TIZ THE LAW left the post parade early, then dropped back after stumbling out of the starting gate on the front end, worked out a tuck into the two path approaching the conclusion of the backstretch, closed the gap while racing between opponents, was on hold caught in traffic for a sixteenth beginning from the quarter pole, angled sharply towards a seam in the three path in the general area of the three-sixteenths pole and into clearance, kicked in when given his cue, exploded to the lead during the run leading up to and then through the furlong grounds, had lengthened away to a comfortable advantage when geared down in the final seventy yards. GREEN LIGHT GO away well, vied for the top right from the get-go, initially from between foes and then from the inside route, matched up with GOZILLA, continued along side by side against that rival for three-quarters, was the first of the duo to have its pilot commit to a drive, this occurring right around the quarter pole, proved powerless when the winner burst upon the scene deep into the furlong grounds, fought on and won the place. BIG CITY BOB off the insde throughout, pursued the pace two to three wide on the turn, got cued up for the drive home, was maneuvered into path four from upper to midlane, flashed some late foot garnering the show. GOZILLA emerged locked up a duel with GREEN LIGHT GO early on the backstretch, took up residence in the two path as they raced as a team showing the way, was coming up to the three-sixteenths marker when switched over to stronger handling, put in a strong bid but failed to cement itself to the top, weakened into the final on-the-board slot in the last stages. ALPHA SIXTY SIX shied in and away from an errant TRUCULENT at the start, was slow to settle into stride, moved out into the three path proceeding on the backstretch, was in the same one entering the turn, was moved out five wide during the first half of the stretch run, came up empty. TRUCULENT corrected after coming in springing from the gate, vied for the lead early from
