## **Footnotes**

FOUR WHEEL DRIVE broke on top but was soon displaced by an on-the-muscle JACK AND NOAH, chose to take up the chase on that one by subtly shifting about so as to ride that foe's cover as best as possible, angled three wide into the stretch, arrived at the three-sixteenths marker and got called upon, grabbed away the advantage deep into the furlong grounds despite coming out slightly from some left side pressure, held a truer course thereafter and kicked clear. FREEWHEELER went inward after the field had been sent on its way, tracked the front runners from just off the hedge, was tipped into the two path for the drive home, got cued up at the three-sixteenths marker, proved no match rallying for the place. EMBOLDEN pursued the pace two to three wide on the turn, got sent out into path four spinning into the lane, finished well enough to get up for the show. JACK AND NOAH (FR) sprinted off from others early on the backstretch, showed the way, at or near the inside route and pulling on the bit all the way to the end of the bend, settled in at the three-sixteentsh pole and was switched over to stronger handling, relinquished to the top one in short order, then weakened in the last eighth. ANOTHER MIRACLE took up the chase from the two path on the bend, swung one path farther off the rail into the stretch, came up empty. TOMATO BILL made contact after leaning to the left with his initial step, got guided over to the hedge, slipped out as the half was being completed and into path two, failed to fire appreciably when called upon.
