

SISTERCHARLIE (IRE) settled just off the inside in mid pack as her stable and barn mate widened away on the front, tipped three wide down the backstretch briefly taking up loose cover behind LANTIZ before that rival tucked in a path, remained in the clear with five furlongs to go and advanced in tandem with the main body of the field on THAIS into and through the far turn coming under light coaxing five-sixteenths out, swung four wide into upper stretch, got roused straightened away, offered up a good kick to issue a challenge and take command nearing the sixteenth marker, then dug in to hold sway to the finish. MRS. SIPPY brushed the near side stall at the start and got away at the tail of the field, settled early on at the rear just off the inside, advanced in concert with the main body of the field on the spurting leader into and through the far turn, remaining patiently handled until angled four to five wide for home, got set down for the drive at that station, offered up a good kick to chase the winner home willingly while clear for the place honors. THAIS (FR) lightly coaxed from the gate, established the front and widened away in hand in the two path through sensible splits, continued to widen down the backstretch to midway, had the field advance mildly approaching the far turn and was given a notch to work with being placed to very light coaxing tucked inside half a mile from home, came under a drive cutting the corner into upper stretch, dug in safe to the eighth pole but under growing threat to the outside, got collared just outside the sixteenth marker and ran on to preserve the show honors. LANTIZ three then two wide leading the main flight well behind the spurting leader, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, spun three wide into upper stretch offering up a mild bid, weakened in the late stages. BEAU BELLE tracked the pace along the inside, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and failed to quicken. FERDINANDA saved ground near the rear of the field, came under a ride three furlongs out, angled out four wide into upper stretch and offered no response. EMPRESSOF THE NILE settled two to three wide near the rear of the field, remained patiently handled until set down angled five wide into upper stretch, offered no kick.
