WICKED WHISPER established control in short order, was guided onto the inside route, was rated along carving out the pace, accompanied by MISS MARISSA to her outside, was still in reserve leading the field into the lane with none having latched on yet, lost little if any of her advantage not being asked for best during the ensuing furlong, got called upon for a response inside the eighth pole, offered up one, edging away from FRANK'S ROCKETTE in the final sixteenth. FRANK'S ROCKETTE off the inside throughout, departed the backstretch from the three path, picked up interest crossing the midway point on the turn, swung into the lane, was given her cue and took off in earnest after the one to catch a sixteenth later, displayed willingness, but failed to dent the deficit. SLAM DUNK took up position in midpack after the field had been sent off and running, angled four wide for the drive home, proved no match securing the show. ICE PRINCESS took up the chase from the two path on the turn, fanned out into path five from upper to midstretch, made no headway in the last eighth. DAPHNE MOON broke the tardiest by about a length after stumbling at the start, dashed over to the rail, rode it for three-quarters, was put to a drive moving to the outside heading for the top of the lane, got worked into path four over the course of the next furlong, made no impact. MISS MARISSA prompted the winner from the two path, pilot applying a firm grip on the reins during the early going, saw the top one inch away from her at the third fraction was being finalized, was under a drive spinning onto the head of the stretch, failed to keep pace and backed away. QUALITY RESPONSE sat forwardly placed along the rail, was sighted pulling on the bit for the opening half, got roused cutting the corner into the lane, came up empty.
