JACKIE'S WARRIOR bumped at the start by REINVESTMENT RISK who broke inwards, established the front and showed the way in hand five then four paths off the inside, tucked three wide through the turn, floated out five wide into upper stretch, carrying REINVESTMENT RISK six wide, got roused straightened away, drew off under a drive and was geared down inside the final sixteenth to prevail comfortably at the end. REINVESTMENT RISK broke in at the start bumping JACKIE'S WARRIOR and continued inwards uncorrected, raced five to six paths off the inside in closest aim of the leader down the backstretch, tucked four wide through the turn, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, got carried out and swung six wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive unable to match the top one through the stretch while along well clear of the rest and second best. MIDNIGHT BOURBON six to seven paths off the inside down the backstretch in range of the leader, tucked five wide through the turn coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung six wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive while well clear of the rest. CIVIL WAR steadied at the start when JACKIE'S WARRIOR was bumped in front by REINVESTMENT RISK, chased four to five down the backstretch, tucked three wide through the turn, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung five wide for home and tired. RUN CASPER RUN brushed the near side stall at the start, chased just off the inside, tucked inside half a mile from home placed to light coaxing, angled four wide for home and tired. AMBIVALENT broke out at the start and was corrected, chased three then two wide under coaxing from the three-eighths, cornered three wide into upper stretch and tired.
