CIVIL UNION settled along the inside near the rear through the opening bend before tipping to track from the two path down the backstretch, remained just off the inside on hold through the far turn, came under coaxing nearing the quarter pole, spun three wide into upper stretch bumping LA SIGNARE to the four path to further open her seam, then shouldered her lightly once more straightened away roused rallying to issue a challenge and take command just inside the eighth pole, dug in under a drive under threat from a pair brushing with NAY LADY NAY a sixteenth from home and under growing threat from MY SISTER NAT and held gamely to victory by a head on the wire. MY SISTER NAT (FR) along the inside at the tail of the field through the first turn, tracked two then three wide down the backstretch and through the far turn coming under coaxing nearing the quarter pole tipping out to swing six wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, closed well outside through the final furlong threatening for it all late but was ultimately rebuffed at the finish. NAY LADY NAY (IRE) just off the inside through the first turn, raced three wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch, got brushed straightened away by LA SIGNARE due to pressure from CIVIL UNION, dug in under a drive issuing a challenge through the final furlong, got brushed lightly near the sixteenth marker as CIVIL UNION came out slightly as MY SISTER NAT joined the fray to the outside, fought on willingly loosely between foes to the finish to secure the show honors clear of the rest. CAMBIER PARC led early on inside before being displaced on the front by LOVELY LUCKY into the first turn and tipped to the two path midway on that bend tracking in closest aim of the leader, remained patiently handled down the backstretch and into the far turn just off the inside, came under coaxing nearing the quarter pole taking closer order, got set down spinning just off the inside for home and seized command straightened away, dug in under a drive under threat, got collared just inside the eighth pole and weakened in the late stages. LA SIGNARE (FR) tracked the pace along the inside, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled out near the quarter pole and was bumped four wide into upper stretch as CIVIL UNION tipped out along her inside, got brushed by that rival straightened away and in turn brushed NAY LADY NAY to her outside, then weakened through the final furlong. BEAU BELLE tracked from just off the pace two to three wide coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch in behind foes outsprinted and offered no response. LOVELY LUCKY forwardly placed from the start, tucked to the two path past the stands for the first time and advanced to take over command into the first turn tucking to the inside once safely clear midway on that bend, showed the way in hand along the inside down the backstretch settled into a comfortable rhythm through sensible splits, came under light coaxing nearing the quarter pole when under pressure for the initial time, cut the corner roused into upper stretch, yielded the front straightened away and weakened.
