The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Footnotes

CRITICAL VALUE came away without apparent mishap, departed the backstretch from the three path, left the three-eighths pole being asked, but not fully so, flashed some interest approximately a sixteenth down the road and crept up, challenged as the widest of three frontrunners abreast of each other entering the stretch, took charge during the ensuing furlong, had built up a sizeable advantage when switched over to being ridden out in the last seventy yards. NAKED AVENGER placed to a firm hold after springing from the gate, was allowed to drop back into a stalking role, did so stationed in the two path, loosely drafted behind another for a good portion of the run around the turn, tipped out slightly and picked it up a bit approaching the quarter pole, got roused fighting for the front from between rivals stepping onto the head of the stretch, saw the pilot applying a firm grip on the right side as she failed to keep pace with the top one, was sighted on the wrong lead during the final furlong yet mustered up some courage to get up for the place. GOOD CREDENCE cut over to the inside with the advantage on the backstretch, was lightly hand urged fending off SARATOGA BEAUTY, saw that one begin to back away in the general area of the five-sixteenths pole only to get pounced upon by a fresher pair of challengers, those being the first two finishers, cut the corner under a drive, succumbed soon afterwards, remained engaged with NAKED AVENGER for place honors and came up the vanquished one. FIRENZE FREEDOM rode the rail for six furlongs, was maneuvered into path five from upper to midstretch, proved to be empty. KNIGHT TRAIN was allowed to settle into stride after breaking the tardiest, gradually made her way towards the inside route, getting there by the conclusion of the backstretch, remained along it bringing up the back of the pack, tipped into the two path spinning into the lane, lacked the necessary response. SARATOGA BEAUTY prompted the pace from path two for over a half before giving way.
