CAPTAIN BOMBASTIC sparred for command from the two path, was let out a notch at the half mile pole, drew up to be directly alongside THREE JOKERS as the third split was about to posted, got let loose for the drive, forged to the front end during the ensuing furlong, felt the presence of CLEON JONES shortly afterwards, was allowed to drift out a bit to meet up with that rival, dug in well to preserve the decision. CLEON JONES along the outside throughout, was in path two in pursuit of the front runners on the turn, commenced the stretch one path farther off the rail, gained ground steadily, but fell short. HARRIS BAY tracked the pace from the pocket, cut the corner into the lane, got outfinished. CITY MAN sluggish along the backstretch, joined up with the others upon completion of the first fraction, vacated the rail for path three at the top of the bend, fanned out into path five from upper to midstretch, was lugging in a bit in the late stages, appearing to be making no headway at the time. THREE JOKERS retained the advantage after narrowly breaking on top, cut over to the inside, showed the way pressed by CAPTAIN BOMBASTIC from the two path, failed to shake that opponent off despite picking up the tempo a few ticks leaving the midway point on the backstretch, was put to the test as three-quarters was being rattled off, relinquished at the furlong grounds and faltered. MISSION WRAPITUP two wide departing the backstretch, was through after going a half.
