FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$1,000 (in addition to the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight, 122 lbs.

Non-winners of a race other than maiden, claiming or starter allowed 2 lbs.; maidens, allowed 4 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. Closed Saturday October 12, 2019 with 39 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the Main Track.) (Rail at 18 feet).

**Footnotes**

BUY LAND AND SEE broke open the gate prior to the start, chased three wide from just off the pace, remained patiently handled losing position to mid pack, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled five to six wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge knocking heads with DON JUAN KITTEN from outside the eighth pole to nearing the sixteenth marker when taking command, inched away briefly before digging in under a drive to hold on and prevail over a fast closing rival. PIXELATE two to three wide at the tail of the field, tucked inside at the half mile pole, came under coaxing nearing the quarter pole and angled out seven wide at the head of the stretch, offered up a good finish to close with a rush but ultimately missed at the end. DON JUAN KITTEN four then three wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command nearing the eighth pole, dug in coming in under threat from BUY LAND AND SEE to the inside, got headed by that foe near the sixteenth marker and was shaken off late while running on safe for the show honors. IRISH MIAS bumped at the start by TIESTO breaking inwards and in turn bumped the back of NOBLE EMOTION, tracked the pace along the inside from just off the pace, got placed to coaxing with five-sixteenths remaining, angled six wide

into upper stretch and kept on to secure the last major share. TALKING two to three wide in aim of the front, remained patiently handled advancing into striking range through the latter portion of the turn and was set down angled four wide into upper stretch, got on near even terms with the leader when a pair went on by to the outside, dug in under a drive and weakened in the late stages. TIESTO broke in brushing the near side stall before bumping IRISH MIAS into NOBLE EMOTION, chased along the inside from mid pack, advanced into striking range into the far turn, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home, stayed on one paced through the stretch and was outkicked. NO LIME three then two wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, angled five wide into upper stretch and offered no response. ME AND MR. C two to three wide in pursuit from near the rear of the field, tipped four wide through the far turn put to coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, went seven wide into upper stretch and offered no response. NOBLE EMOTION bobbed at the break, then got bumped behind by IRISH MIAS, established the front and showed the way in hand along the inside, remained patiently handled until let out spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, yielded the front nearing the eighth pole and tired. GET SMOKIN three then two wide in aim of the leader under a rating hold, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, swung three wide into upper stretch and backed away.
