By subscription of \$250 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,250 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$2,500 (in addition to the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a race other than maiden, claiming or starter allowed 2 lbs.; all maidens, 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Footnotes

VENTI VALENTINE away near the rear of the field when breaking inwards, advanced inside to settle in pursuit from just off the pace, came under coaxing near the quarter pole, spun just off the inside for home taking over command straightened away into upper stretch, then edged clear under a drive kept to task. CAPTAINSDAUGHTER broke out at the start and was corrected, chased three to four wide under coaxing from the three-eighths, angled five wide into upper stretch and kicked on belatedly to secure the place honors while never threatening the winner. DUFRESNE crossed to the inside after the start and saved ground in pursuit, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun just off the inside for home and improved position offering up late foot. VELVET SISTER five paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked to the two path nine-sixteenths from home, came under coaxing near the three-eighths and tipped out three then four wide offering a bid into contention at the quarter pole, dug in under a drive and weakened in the final furlong. CLASSIC LYNNE five then four wide in pursuit, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide for home and weakened. SANDY'S GARDEN showed the way in hand from the two path, tucked inside nine-sixteenths from home, came under threat near the quarter pole and cut the corner into upper stretch, yielded the front straightened away and tired. VALLELUJAH two to three wide in pursuit, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled four wide into upper stretch and tired. SUE ELLEN MISHKIN prompted the leader from the outside three to four paths off the rail before tucking two to three wide through the turn, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, faded, swung three wide for home and faltered. LUZ six paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked three wide

through the turn coming under coaxing midway, swung three to four wide for home, got placed to a protective hold and was guided to the outside before being pulled up in the vicinity of the eighth pole and was subsequently vanned off.
