Supplemental nominations of \$5,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$100,000 Guaranteed (Includes \$36,250 from Mystic Lake purse Enhancement Fund) (Includes \$27,500 from the Minnesota Breeders Fund) (Plus \$10,000 from the Minnesota Breeders Fund for horses Sired & Foaled in Minnesota) of which \$60,000 to the owner of the winner. All other purse monies paid corresponding with purse schedule in the Condition Book. Weight: 120 lbs. Maidens allowed 5 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Northern Lights Futurity will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. High weights on the scale will be preferred. Total earnings will be used in determining the order of preference of horses assigned equal weights. Failure to draw into the race will result in a refund of the entry fee. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Monday, April 1 with 36. (S)

Footnotes

HAPPY HOUR COWBOY, in touch with the first flight three deep between foes attending the pace on his own courage, was prompted to press the issue leaving the midway point of the turn, edged nearing midstretch and held sway to the end under firm handling. PUBLIC SAFETY tracked off the first flight along the inside, shifted out three wide racing into the lane and continued willingly to the end while failing to gain even terms with the winner. BIG FALCON ROCKET, urged along the rail pressing the pace in the opening quarter, lost some position to the leaders nearing the stretch, angled out in upper stretch and produced a solid second effort to prevail for a share. LIL' NINJA ducked out at the start bumping YOU SAY SO, was righted, then urged between foes disputing the pace from the outset into the turn, then gave way inside foes midstretch. MACHO RAPIDO, bumped at the start, settled last, angled to the inside on the turn but failed to menace. CAMEL ANGEL flashed brief pace four wide pursuing the leaders to the turn but emptied out early. YOU SAY SO, bumped, then forced into a rival at the start, was collected to track between foes but faded early.
