SASSY SENECA broke well then attended the early pace set by RICHARD RONALD, came through on the inside to take the lead at the quarter pole, lost command briefly to RICHARD RONALD at the top of the lane but dug in to the furlong pole and held sway late. RICHARD RONALD was off well on the outside, dictated the pace into the bend, lost the lead nearing the quarter pole then came again to take a brief lead at the top of the stretch and weakened to be second best. HURTS SO GOOD was bumped at the break, chased the pace on the inside into the bend, angled three wide at the top of the lane and finished evenly in the stretch. BLAZIN' ASIAN veered in at the break bumping HURTS SO GOOD then trailed throughout.
