TOM'S D'ETAT tracked the pace early on, stuck a nose in front near the three eighths pole, was in the five path into the lane then drew away late in the stretch while ridden out to the wire. BY MY STANDARDS chased the pace early on, made a bid near the three eighths pole, was in the five path into the lane and no match for the winner in the stretch run but was second best. SILVER DUST raced back early on, was in the five path into the lane and moved up in the stretch run. MULTIPLIER chased the pace early, was in the four path into the lane and flattened out late in the stretch run. OWENDALE raced back early on, was in the five path into the lane and improved position. FEARLESS trailed the field early on, was in the five path into the lane and improved position in the stretch drive. PIRATE'S PUNCH set the pace early, was in the three path into the stretch and gave way down the lane. ALKHAATAM was through after a half.
