

SIGNALMAN chased the pace early along the inside, angled off the rail into the while waiting for running room, found a path then split horses in the stretch, was under a long drive, inched clear in the final sixteenth and held off late rival in the final stages. PLUS QUE PARFAIT was unhurried early on, swung into the six path in the far turn, rallied into the lane, made a bid three wide in the stretch while under a long drive but did not have enough in the late stages. LIMONITE raced back early on, swung into the six path in the far turn, rallied down the lane, made a bid four wide late and was gaining in the final stages. KING FOR A DAY chased the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn while making a bid, was under a long drive in the stretch from between

horses and yielded late in the drive. ROILAND broke a bit slowly from the gate and trailed the field early on, shifted into the three path entering the lane and moved up in the stretch run. TRACKSMITH was back early on, shifted into the four path in the far turn, made a bid down the lane but weakened late in the drive. CURRENT was bumped and bothered at the start, fanned into the five path in the far turn and improved position down the lane. TOPPER T set the pace early, was on the inside into the lane and gave way in the stretch. DUNPH chased the pace early, fanned into the five path in the far turn and faded in the stretch. ROYAL URN came out at the start and was through after three quarters. KNICKS GO tracked the pace early, shifted into the three path in the far turn and was empty down the lane. MICK'S STAR was through after a half. BLUE STEEL had early speed then folded up. EVERFAST was never involved.
