SILVER PROSPECTOR was well placed early on, shifted into the four path in the far turn, bid three wide down the lane, was under long drive and edged clear in the final stages. FINNICK THE FIERCE raced back early on along the outside, was in the five path entering the lane, made a bid down the lane, was three wide late, got up for place but did not have enough to the winner. TIZ THE LAW stalked the pace early while pocketed, waited for room along the far turn and in the upper stretch, was asked near the three sixteenths, under a long drive while on the inside of the winner late, did not have enough in the final stages and lost the place spot. ENFORCEABLE trailed the field early on, shifted into the four path in the far turn, rallied down the lane and was gaining in the late stages. NEW EAGLE set the pace early, was on the inside into the lane and yielded late in the stretch run. SOUTH BEND tracked the pace early, shifted into the three path in the far turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. FIGHTING SEABEE chased the pace early, was off the rail into the lane and leveled off late in the stretch. TWO LAST WORDS stalked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn and faded down the lane.
