Footnotes

FINITE stalked the pace early inside, moved out three wide along the backstretch, remained three wide nearing the quarter pole, took over command down the lane, was under a long drive, dug in and kept foe at bay in the final stages. MOTU came out at the start and raced back early on, shifted into the four path in the far turn while making a bid, continued the bid down the lane but was kept at bay in the final stages. LADY GLAMOUR tracked the pace early, inched ahead foe foes near the five sixteenths pole, was off the rail into the lane but was no match for the top two down the lane. SHE CAN'T SING chased the pace early, was on the inside into the lane and leveled off late in the stretch run. TURTLE TRAX hopped at the start and trailed the field early on, shifted into the four path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch drive. HIS GLORY chased the pace early, fanned into the five path in the far turn and faded down the lane. BEAN set the pace for a half then folded up. IVYETSU was out of control along the first turn and was tired down the lane.
