Footnotes

TWIRLING OWEN set a clear pace leaving the half mile pole, widened the advantage through the turn and was steadily handled to deep stretch. VIRGINIA PEACH chased the pace inside then checked at the rail toward the five sixteenths pole, angled to the four path entering the stretch and dug in to take second later yards. COACH RUBE came away a step slow then picked up the chase, rounded the turn about the four path, left the turn outside and got up for third the final yards. GANDHI'S CASTLE gave chase through the backstretch, rounded the turn at the rail then flattened stride inside the eighth pole. Q'S SONG gave early chase about the three path, steadied off the heels of Gandhi's Castle and Undeniable Touch past the three sixteenths pole and showed little more. UNDENIABLE TOUCH chased the leaders from the outside, rounded the turn in the three path then weakened.
