ANGLE OF ATTACK angled in to race with the pace two deep through the front stretch then stalked into the opening turn, challenged leaving the three eighths pole, contested at a close disadvantage through the far turn but dug in under determined handling from the head of the lane to take the nod through the final strides. BOUNDTOBEBAD took quick control of the pace inside then dug in to the challenge of Angle Of Attack leaving the three eighths pole, gamely kept the advantage past that point but grudgingly ceded the nod through the final strides. THE BETTER ONE settled off the pace about the three path, bid toward the three eighths pole, continued in the three path of the far turn and finished well. CANDYFORACAUSE settled off the pace and off the rail, started a bid toward the three eighths pole, came through the far turn at the rail and raced evenly to deep stretch before flattening stride. CAMPANIA settled back saving early ground and was never a factor. NAVY SWORD stalked the pace off the rail, gave chase leaving the seven sixteenths pole then faded at the rail rounding the far turn.
