SHANG forwardly placed while racing off the inside, stalked the two leaders in the three path backstretch, roused for the drive, late surge to get to the winner late. CLASSY JOHN dueled up front past the wire the first time in hand, allowed the leader to go the middle half, reengaged that rival far turn, shook clear, led late, could not contain the winner, far clear of the others. JIMI'S A STAR settled off the pace and the inside, three wide under the whip exiting the final turn, no match top two, well clear of the others. CAFE DU MONDE went evenly paced while racing in the two path. MUSADA dueled early inside the runner up, showed the way up the backstretch, briefly clear, faltered when headed final turn. KANTIANA broke in, bothered rival, never a threat. MR. FOUR SEVENS bothered at the start, trailed throughout.
