COLLUSION ILLUSION chased off the rail then outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, rallied under urging to the lead outside foes in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. WRECKING CREW broke in and behind the field, settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and edged a rival late for the place. FORE LEFT stalked outside a rival then bid three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch, drifted in some in the final furlong and was edged for second. THANKS MR. EIDSON had good early speed between horses then dueled outside a rival, battled between foes leaving the turn, drifted out some into the stretch, inched away in midstretch, drifted in past the eighth pole and was outfinished late. WE'RE STILL HERE stalked a bit off the rail to the stretch, went around a rival in deep stretch and could not quite summon the needed late kick. RAGING WHISKEY had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn, was in tight along the rail past the eighth pole and weakened late.
