CAKEWALK dueled for the lead from the inside with MUNNY, disposed of that rival after going a half, opened a clear lead and drew off through the lane with complete authority. WINDY POINT broke in to bump rival, then was reserved just off the leaders, moved four-wide through the turn, reached a striking position but failed to gain on the winner late. YOU GO GIRL was bumped at the start, checked repeatedly, moved four-wide through the turn and finished with good late interest. FOR YOU ONLY was away in good order to press the pace from between foes, saved ground through the turn and finished evenly late. MY FOL lacked early foot, raced five-wide through the turn and did not menace. TAP THAT SPOT settled off the leaders early, moved three-wide through the turn and failed to rally. MUNNY broke sharply to dispute the early pace with the winner while racing three-wide and weakened after going a half. JADED TIGER was bumped from both sides at the break, showed no early speed, raced three-wide through the turn and was not a factor.
