KASSERINE PASS close up from the start, pressed three wide backstretch, vied, took over from the outside late in the turn, clear in upper stretch,drifted out, was straightened and remained clear to the wire while kept to pressure. WHERE'S MOM lacked early foot, saved some ground in the turn, angled out a bit for the drive, lugged in on two occasions but finished up willingly to be clearly second best and to be closing the gap on the winner late. SCHIFF'S CORNER forced the issue early in the two path, between foes when challenging inside the winner in the turn, could not match that one or contain the runner up in the run to the wire, well in front of the others. CALAJA behind the first flight while racing outside, came up empty for the drive. JOE G'S PAYBACK narrowly set the pace along the inside up the backstretch, continued to contest the issue along the rail turn, gave way in the drive. MARAMA bobbed at the start to be off slowly, trailed throughout.
