X CLOWN outrun in the early going outside, continued to trail turn, asked along with just over a quarter remaining, swung five wide turning for home, rallied under brisk handling, late bid, edging away late. ELUSIVE D'ORO narrowly set pace from between foes early, dueled through the turn, shook off the other speed to be clear in midstretch, could not contain the winner, remained clear for the place. FREE INDEED vied early inside the runner up, fell back off that one and the other early speed turn, continued to save ground into the lane, could not get back to the front in finishing up evenly and best of the others. BUY IN vied up front early while between rivals, also fell back in the run into and through the turn, one paced as well through the lane in lacking a late punch. THIRSTY WILDCAT behind the early pace, raced in the second turn to improve position a bit in the turn, had little left for the stretch drive. SCOTTY BOY restless in the gate, vied early in the four path, dueled through the turn outside the runner up, faded in the drive.
