WAR OF WILL went four wide early on the first turn then shifted to the five path, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid in the three then four path on the far turn, was asked while in front at the top of the stretch and drew away under strong urging. HOG CREEK HUSTLE was hard held in the three path on the first turn then reserved off the pace, went four wide early on the far turn, was roused near the five-sixteenths then moved to the five path, came seven wide into the stretch and safely secured the place while no match for the winner. MANNY WAH went five then four wide on the first turn, disputed the pace on the outside, vied in the two path on the far turn, lost touch with the winner while under a drive in upper stretch and weakened but held the show. WICKED INDEED was well placed on the inside, drafted behind horses on the far turn, was asked while moving to the two path outside the quarter-pole, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. PLUS QUE PARFAIT stumbled at the start then bumped with a foe, went four wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside, came under urging in the four path on the far turn, shifted six wide into the stretch and also lacked the needed response. CHASE THE GHOST bumped with a rival at the start, went three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, rounded the far turn in the two path, came under a drive in upper stretch and failed to rally. ROILAND was slow into stride, saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear, started the far turn in the two path, angled to the four path near the five-sixteenths, came six wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. NIGHT OPS saved ground on the first turn,

settled towards the rear, was roused in the two path on the far turn and was no factor. TACKETT was hustled from the start, went three wide on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, went two then three wide on the far turn, was driven past the five-sixteenths, came five wide into the stretch and capitulated. TIGHT TEN bumped with rivals on both sides at the start, went four wide on the first turn, settled near the back on the outside, was bumped midway down the backstretch, came under urging in the three path on the far turn and failed to respond. MALPAIS went to the front, raced inside to the two path on the first turn, contested the pace on the inside of an opponent, vied inside on the far turn, dropped back approaching the quarter-pole and stopped. MO SPEED was very reluctant to load, went two to three wide on the first turn, lugged out midway down the backstretch and bumped with a foe, dropped back in the three to four path on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and was pulled up then walked off.
