WAR OF WILL was asked to establish position leaving the gate, went four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace down the backstretch, engaged the leader while three wide early on the far turn, took the lead just inside the three-eighths, moved clear approaching the quarter-pole, responded well in the stretch and held under steady urging. COUNTRY HOUSE was off slow, spotted the front a couple of lengths, moved in near the back, raced inside early on the first turn then moved to the two path, settled towards the rear, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, came between horses at the

five-sixteenths, gained five wide into the stretch, lugged in near the three-sixteenths then was straightened by the rider and finished willingly for the place. ROILAND was off slow, spotted the front a few lengths, saved ground while urged along at the rear, came three wide into the stretch, angled out under a drive near the three-sixteenths and finished with late energy for the show. HOG CREEK HUSTLE checked sharply towards the inside early, went two then three wide on the first turn, moved out entering the backstretch, settled on the far outside, was urged along while five then six wide on the far turn, came seven wide into the stretch under the whip and lacked the needed response. LIMONITE raced in the two path early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, settled under some urging, saved ground on the far turn, steadied behind horses near the three-sixteenths, came between rivals into the final furlong and improved position. MANNY WAH settled on the inside, drafted along the rail on the far turn, lacked room turning into the stretch, came out at the three-sixteenths, bumped with CHASE THE GHOST shortly thereafter and steadied then weakened. MR. MONEY went three wide on the first turn, settled towards the front, ranged up while four wide on the far turn, chased the winner into upper stretch, was taken up when COUNTRY HOUSE lugged inward in front of him outside the furlong marker and tired. OWENDALE was hustled early, went four wide on the first turn, was urged along while off the pace, raced four wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. CHASE THE GHOST was rated on the inside, came under urging on the far turn, moved to the two path late on that bend, bumped with MANNY WAH in upper stretch and had nothing left. HENLEY'S JOY went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along passing the half-mile pole, raced three wide while between horses on the far turn, was carried out some outside the furlong marker and came up empty. DUNPH was hustled from the start, angled in while showing speed, rounded the first turn in the two path, was well placed down the backstretch, chased in the two path on the far turn, was taken up while dropping back outside the furlong marker and capitulated. GUN IT showed speed from the outside post, went five wide early on the first turn, dropped to three wide while moving clear late on that bend, set the pace through solid fractions, was asked in the two path when confronted by the winner on the far turn, lost the lead inside the three-eighths, dropped back into upper stretch, was taken up while falling out of contention at the furlong marker and faded. PLUS QUE PARFAIT went around the first turn in the two path, settled off the pace, was urged along between horses in the two path on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond. FROLIC MORE went five wide on the first turn, settled on the far outside, dropped back between horses leaving the backstretch, went four then five wide on the far turn, floated seven wide into the stretch and faltered.
