FOR TWO YEAR OLD FILLIES. Free nomination by Saturday, December 7. \$375 to enter; \$375 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$75,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to finishers sixth through ninth. Any unpaid purse monies will revert to the winner. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$65,000 allowed 2 lbs, \$55,000 allowed 4 lbs, \$45,000 allowed 6 lbs (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Letellier Memorial Stakes will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference will be given in the following manner: graded or group winners in order (I, II, III), then highest lifetime earnings. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee or supplementary nomination fee if applicable. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations Closed Saturday, December 7, 2019 with 22 nominations.

TARAZ broke out then established control soon after the start, dictated terms in the two path through the turn, easily disposed of the runner-up outside the quarter-pole, drew off under her own power in upper stretch, widened under very mild hand urging into the final sixteenth then was put to even lighter encouragement late while much the best. URSULA broke out and brushed the gate, moved up on the outside then tracked the pace, made a bid in the three path under urging on the turn, lost touch with the winner coming to the quarter-pole and proved no match while clear for the place. SWEET KISSES bumped with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, moved out then was put to urging near the half-mile pole, went four wide on the turn, turned into the stretch under the whip and came up empty while able to get the show. GEE SHE SPARKLES bumped with a foe at the start, was urged along off the pace, rounded the turn in the two path, angled five wide into the stretch and failed to respond. STREET FLYER came out just after the start then was corrected by the rider, chased the pace on the inside, dropped back while saving ground on the turn, was driven into the stretch in the two path, drifted out near the furlong marker and stopped.
