OUR LOST LOVE was well rated while setting the pace in the two path, responded well when shaken up in upper stretch, shook off the runner-up into the final furlong and proved best under a solid hand ride. LIZZY'S STAR raced just off the pace, went three wide on the turn, was given her cue at the five-sixteenths, made a bid under the whip into the stretch, battled outside of the winner in the drive and was outfinished while clear for the place. VACHERIE GIRL was away alertly then hustled, raced just off the pace under urging, tucked into the three path on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while well clear for the show. LUCKY ARTIE jostled with a rival early, settled under some urging, moved up midway down the backstretch then was taken in hand while in traffic, rounded the turn in the two path, was roused at the five-sixteenths and came up empty. ORETTA hit the inside of the gate at the start, raced just off the pace, steadied near the seven-sixteenths then dropped back against the rail, angled four then five wide around the three-eighths, came six wide into the stretch and failed to respond. LADY BE GONE jostled with a foe early, moved up while urged along, drafted inside on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole then shifted out and also came up empty. LONE STAR DIVA was pinched back early, raced at the rear of the field, went around the turn in the two path, came four wide into the stretch then dropped in at the three-sixteenths and was no factor. SING THE SONG tracked the pace on the outside, went four wide on the turn, dropped back into the stretch and faltered then was eased late but walked off.
