X CLOWN bumped with a rival at the start, pressed the pace between horses, bumped with foes on both sides near the half-mile pole, dropped back leaving the backstretch, rounded most of the turn in the two path then shifted three wide, came four wide into the stretch, made a bid inside the three-sixteenths, drifted out near the sixteenth-pole and narrowly prevailed. REACH THE CIRCLE was urged along on the outside, bumped with a foe at the half-mile pole, went five wide on the turn, made a bid inside the three-sixteenths, was carried out by the winner around the sixteenth-pole and just missed while able to get the place. FAST VERDICT was urged along on the outside, went three to four wide on the turn and finished with good energy to get the show. GUITAR TRIBUTE brushed with a foe at the start, angled in while ridden along towards the back, went four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, angled out in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths and finished well to get the last spot in the superfecta. RICHARD RONALD bumped with a rival at the start, was coaxed along off the pace, chased four then three wide on the turn, took the lead at the quarter-pole, lost the advantage outside the furlong marker and weakened. LOUISIANA HERO angled in while ridden along towards the rear, moved from three to five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. TOO MUCH BOURBON was urged along off the pace, bumped with a rival at the half-mile pole then steadied, went two to three wide on

the turn and failed to rally. ALTERANA disputed the pace on the outside of two foes, bumped with a rival near the half-mile pole, led while dropping from three to two wide on the turn, lost the lead at the quarter-pole and gave way. FREE INDEED was sent hard from the start, contested the pace on the inside, bumped with a foe near the half-mile pole, chased inside on the turn and tired. WHACUDPOSBLYGOWRNG settled off the pace, moved in near the half-mile pole, raced inside early on the turn, angled three wide at the five-sixteenths, moved out in upper stretch, drifted in near the sixteenth-pole and capitulated. LUCKENBACHER brushed with a rival at the start, was ridden along at the rear, rounded the turn in the two path, came three wide into the stretch and was no factor.
