Footnotes

ANOTHERWISTAFATE broke alertly and was on the pace to the second turn, responded when roused and kicked away to mid stretch and was under hand urging only in the drive. KINGLY pressed the winner three wide to the stretch, got outkicked to mid stretch but was not threatened for second. MORE ICE was five wide to the backstretch, settled to the second turn, raced three wide to the stretch but could not threaten the top two. ANGELO'S PRIDE was settled early while outside rivals, got fanned five wide on the second turn then finished evenly in the drive. WEEKLY CALL tracked the leaders to the half mile pole while three wide, was between rivals and squeezed at the three eighths, steadied then recovered but was not a threat. MAYOR COBB trailed to the second turn, raced three wide to the stretch but could only pick off rivals in the drive. THE CREEP tracked the pace to the second turn, was two wide to

the stretch then weakened. REY COLIMAN had no speed, was forced to circle five wide to the stretch and did not respond. DATA HAWK had no speed and was not a factor. KING OF SPEED settled early then pushed up inside rivals nearing the half mile pole to briefly loom a threat but gave out after six furlongs. KNIGHT'S CROSS chased the pace to the second turn, was asked four wide to the stretch but gave out.
