BETTOR TRIP NICK was quickest and went right to the front, set the pace to the second turn, responded when set down for the drive and held doggedly. SACRED RIDER pressed the winner throughout, was two wide to the stretch then could not catch that one but kept on to hold second. MUSIC ICON was settled to the half, bid three wide on the second turn and was closing ground determinedly. INDIAN PEAK got outsprinted to the backstretch, settled to the half, was fanned four wide to the stretch then lacked a closing bid. CHAMPERS chased the leaders to the second turn, was three wide to the stretch and weakened late. RAGER brushed the gate coming out and was choppy in the early going, trailed to the second turn, saved ground but was not a threat. FINAL FINAL had no speed, settled to the second turn, raced two wide to the stretch then also did not threaten. JEDI KNIGHT stalked the winner to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch then gave way. CALL ME PEPPY tracked the pace to the second turn, stopped after six furlongs then was eased in the stretch but walked off.
