After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a race other than maiden or claiming allowed 2 lbs; a race other than claiming, 4 lbs; a race, 6 lbs. Starters to be named by usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters. Preference will be given by highest career earnings. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile) (Rail at 96 feet).

Footnotes

ONYX raced two wide around the first turn then settled off the pace through early stages, prompted and advanced willingly entering the far turn and loomed up taking slim lead turning for home, quickly cleared on top and kept sharp under steady pressure. MADAME BOURBON raced two wide around the first turn then rated near mid-range down the backstretch, advanced three wide and gained close contention in the far turn then continued a steady effort through the lane and finished clearly second best. GRAN BRANDY secured inside position in the first turn then rated along inside through the backstretch, picked up the pace along the inside around the far turn then shifted wider turning for home, moved closer to the inside under left handed pressure through the lane and cleared share. MARAMA was taken back and saved ground through the backstretch, hustled up along the rail around the far turn then steadied in upper stretch and improved position without threatening. ADDILYN was allowed to settle out of the gate then raced off the pace, came under a ride and raced five wide entering top stretch and failed to kick on. CEDAR HALL was forwardly placed in the first turn and prompted the pace down the backstretch, launched a two wide bid for the lead around the far turn then faded in the lane. WHYCANTHISBELOVE held a slim lead around the first turn, set a pressured pace down the backstretch and into the far turn then tired in the drive. LITTLE MARIA was forwardly placed and raced three wide around the first turn, stalked the top two leaders down the backstretch then came under a ride along inside in the far turn, failed to advance then faded.
