**Footnotes**

SOROS steadily moved over to the inside and settled nicely through early stages, angled out mid-way through the turn and loomed up four wide turning for home, was driven to command in upper stretch and finished clear. GENGHIS raced three to four wide off the early pace, launched a bid along the outside moving through the turn, was set down driving six wide at head of the lane, gathered momentum under pressure and produced a solid finish. GANGLY saved ground while rated through early stages, angled out and launched a bid nearing the quarter pole, switched in couple paths in stretch and stayed on with response. GEMO was forwardly placed racing up close through the backstretch then prompted and took over the lead entering the turn, continued on top under steady pressure then got collared by winner in upper stretch and gave way. PERUVIAN BOY raced in good spot settled near midpack down the backstretch, prompted and advanced four wide in the turn, raced in close contention turning for home then flattened out in the lane. MY FIRST GRAMMY raced in the back then saved ground around far turn, stayed along the inside in stretch run and gained position without threatening. POE raced in the second flight going by the half mile marker, hustled up three wide and raced in close contention around the turn then failed to sustain bid in the lane. AT THE BEACH stumbled at the start, raced off the pace along the outside and failed to move on when called upon. FORT MCHENRY raced in the second flight going by the half mile marker, chased around the turn then faded in the lane. D'ARCHER sped to the lead then ducked in near the gap and steadied, straightened out and held a slim lead through the backstretch then retreated in the turn.
